

OVERVIEW OF EXEMPTION CATEGORIES

Updated February 2024

Written approval from FFNC is required <u>prior to participation</u> to validate an exemption to the normal conditions that apply to any FFNC Regulation in relation to any nominated player or team.

EXEMPTION TYPE 1

MINIROOS/JUNIOR player to participate in YOUNGER age competition.

EXEMPTION TYPE 2

Register MORE THAN the maximum number of players in a squad as specified in FFNC Competition Regulations (not applicable for Grades 12 - 16).

EXEMPTION TYPE 3

<u>SENIOR</u> player to be graded <u>MORE THAN TWO leagues</u> below the player's last grading in FFNC (any previous season in last five years).

EXEMPTION TYPE 4

<u>SENIOR</u> player to be re-graded (above or below) the initial league nominated on the 2024 Squad List submitted to FFNC.

EXEMPTION TYPE 5

<u>OTHER</u> (where not specified above and only where not otherwise being prohibited as a consequence of the request being contrary to regulations as defined by FFNC, NNSWF or FA).

MATTERS THAT ARE NOT CONSIDERED FOR EXEMPTION

- 1. Participation <u>MORE than SIX (6) times</u> in any HIGHER league/competition where distinct from any approval given for a junior player to do so.
- 2. Participation of a JUNIOR player ACROSS divisions.
- 3. DUAL registration unless approved as an "exceptional circumstance" that would typically be limited to a JUNIOR player (generally MiniRoos) who is subject to a custody dispute between parents.
- 4. Participation of a player in a SENIOR league who is NOT yet aged 14 years.
- 5. Participation of a player in a JUNIOR competition MORE THAN TWO (2) years above the player's eligible age/grade*. (*Special circumstances such as marginal age disparity may be considered at the assessment of FFNC).
- 6. Where a player is considered to be physically (or otherwise identified) as being inappropriate to compete in a YOUNGER junior competition.
- 7. Where FFNC concludes that it is inappropriate for a player to be given a concession to participate in a specific competition.
