
Senior League Teams

Outfield Players

Each outfield player in each same team must be wearing a shirt that is the same colour and design as their teammates.


Each outfield player in each same team must be wearing shorts that are the same colour and design as their teammates.



Club Socks

Goalkeepers


Junior Competition Teams (ages 12 – 16)

Each <u>outfield</u> player in each same team must be wearing a <u>shirt</u> that is the same colour and design as their teammates.


